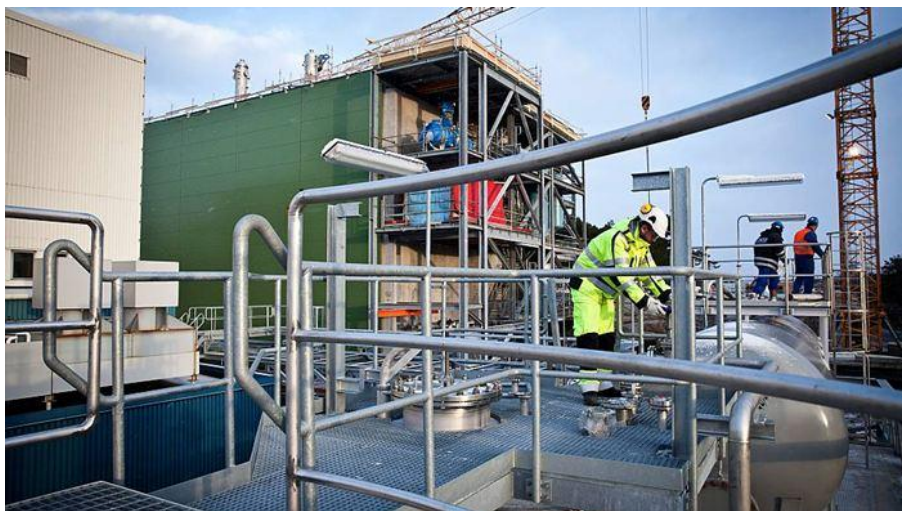
Study Visits

A. Astra Zeneca premises in Mölndal (Confirmed)



AstraZeneca is a global, innovation-driven biopharmaceutical business with a primary focus on the discovery, development and commercialization of prescription medicines for gastrointestinal, cardiovascular, neuroscience, respiratory and inflammation, oncology and infectious disease. Astra Zeneca employs approximately 60 000 people worldwide, 2500 of them in Mölndal, one of its three Global R&D strategic centres.

B. GoBiGas (*Gothenburg Biomass Gasification*) (confirmed)



GoBiGas is a Göteborg Energi initiative to develop the energy alternative of tomorrow. Göteborg Energi is Western Sweden's leading energy company, providing energy services, broadband, district heating, cooling, natural gas and the electricity supply network (turnover 2012, MSEK 6 956). In spring 2007, the world's largest biogas upgrading facility, opened in Gothenburg. Göteborg Energi is keen to establish more partnerships with various other organizations, with the aim of continuing the development of biogas - the fuel of the future.

Göteborg Energi's GoBiGas-project aims to partially demonstrate the possibilities with gasification technology and partially build a plant which can provide for the growing need for renewable and CO₂-neutral biogas. Phase 1 of the project is partly being funded through a grant from the Energy Agency in the amount of 222 million SEK.

C. Preem (TBC)



Preem is responsible for 80 percent of Swedish refinery capacity and 30 percent of Nordic capacity. In Preemraff Göteborg, Preem's biorefinery in West Sweden, crude tall diesel is converted into renewable diesel that comprises hydrocarbon equivalent to that in fossil diesel. It is then processed together with fossil raw materials to produce a diesel with renewable ingredients.
